ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The Canadian Pacific Railway (CP) and Kansas City Southern Railway (KCS) filed an application with the Surface Transportation Board (Board) seeking the Board's approval for CP to acquire control of KCS. This acquisition would create the first railroad that connects Canada, the United States, and Mexico.

As part of the approval review process, the Board will evaluate potential impacts of the project on the environment. The Board will hold online meetings to present the project and take comments.
